TALKING TEENS 📭



Family Thrive Early Help Co-ordinators are running a free course for parents or carers of teenagers and pre-teens who are looking to better understand and communicate with them – It offers an opportunity to understand what's going on in the adolescent brain and how to understand their feelings and behaviours using an authoritative parenting style. Sessions will focus on relationships within the family, communication, negotiation, decision-making and strategies to reduce conflict.

The group aims to develop:

- relationships between teenagers and parents/carers
- a calmer home life
- confidence when talking about difficult issues
- an understanding of teenage needs and development

Who would be eligible to attend this course?

- Parents and carers of pre-teens and teenagers who are currently in years 6 & 7 but there may be availability for years 5 & 8
- There is no physical or extremely challenging behaviour present in or outside of the family home. This course focuses on the importance of empathy and positive discipline
- · Family must reside in Lewisham borough or child must attend a Lewisham school

How long is the course?

- · Each group is 4 sessions over the course of 4 weeks
- 2 hours per session (10.00am-12.00pm)

SWOY Citizens have had two meetings so far. We discussed the results of the Listening Campaign and the issues that mattered most. The top two issues cited were Housing and Mental Health and Well-Being. Given the work on housing is well established and ongoing, it was decided the focus would be on mental health and well- being. One idea put forward is for a community gathering be it a lunch or a tea to be held in the upper hall on a quarterly basis. This would be for people who live alone or who are socially isolated. We were particularly keen for one of the dates to be at Christmas. We would like to invite you to suggest any other ideas you may have to support the Mental Health and Well-Being in our community. We will be outside Mass on the weekend of 13th and 14th April to listen to ideas and answer any questions. If you wish, you can record your ideas on the form below.

London Citizens 2024 Mayoral Accountability Assembly Thursday 25th April; 18.00-20.00; Methodist Central Hall, Westminster.

You are invited to the London Citizens Mayoral Accountability Assembly where we will hold the next Mayor of London to account on issues that affect our local communities. The candidates attending are Susan Hall; Conservative, Sadiq Khan; Labour.

Agenda:

- 1. Work and Wages: Ensure all in our city benefit from a real Living Wage and Living Hours by influencing key sectors and using the powers of the GLA
- 2. Housing and Repairs: Address the dire need for affordable, safe, and sustainable housing to foster a sense of security and belonging among residents, through building more Community Land Trust homes, tackling rogue landlords, and quicker repairs and retrofit in social housing.
- Migrants and Refugees: Provide asylum seekers access to free bus travel, support ESOL through publicity campaigns, an annual ESOL day with the Deputy Mayor for Skills and funding for childcare, and support our national campaign on fair pathways to Citizenship.

This assembly is a beacon of hope and a platform for meaningful social dialogue between London Citizens and the mayoral candidates.
