Dear Parents,

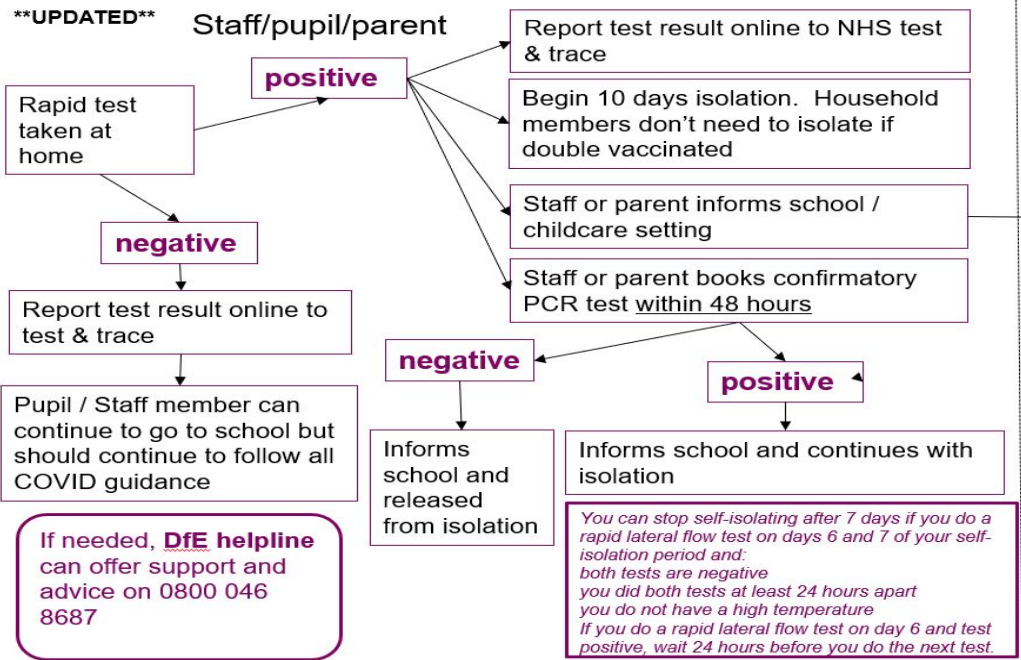

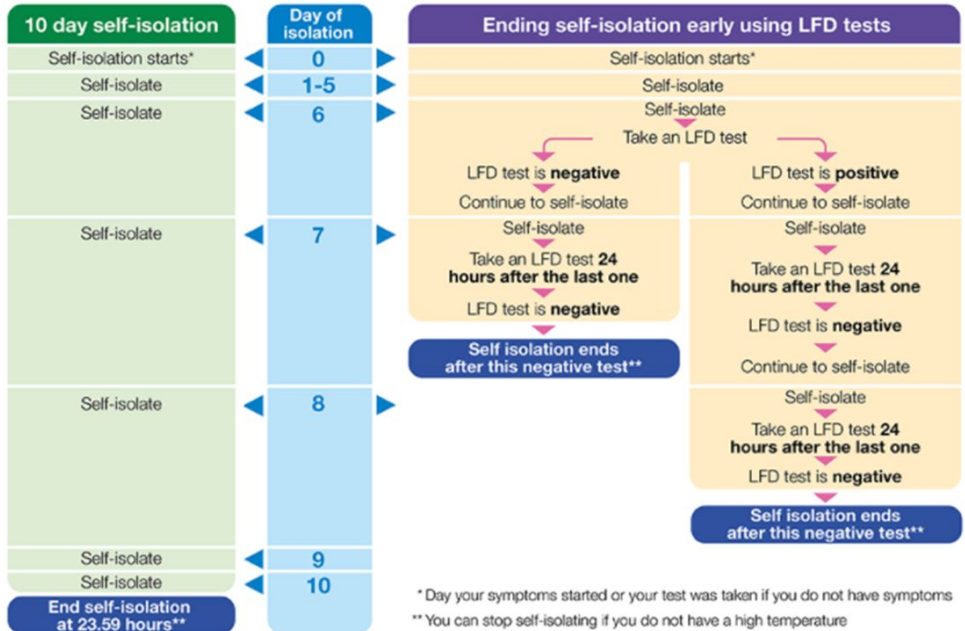


The flowchart below explains the rules regarding self isolation, if you, or your child, has had a PCR or a Positive Lateral Flow Test. Day ZERO is the day of the positive result with an LFD or a PCR. Parents must share the confirmation of a NEGATIVE LFD on day 6 and Day 7, with the school, so it must be registered via the NHS website
